Enjoyment. Sex. Power.


Rather, think about it as our men being motivated by a spirit other than the Spirit of God

SIX PRINCIPLES

1. Life and not Legalism

Legalism offers the "rules of life"; Babylon offers "life without rules".

From the time they are children, men need to be convinced that the greatest desire that God has for them is to live a transformed life from which comes the abundant life.

Compared to legalism, it is Babylon that men can hardly refuse.
